

Lesson 2. Edit Video Clips in iMovie HD

There are several ways to edit a video clip.

You can trim the beginning, end or middle of a clip; crop a section of a clip; or split a clip into two separate clips.

You can edit clips in the Clips pane or in your movie timeline.

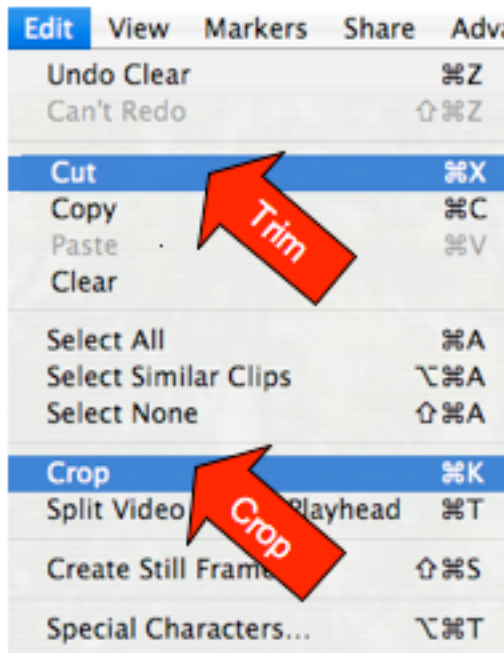
- 1 In order to edit a video clip, you must select the clip. You can use the scrubber bar in the preview window to highlight a section of the clip.



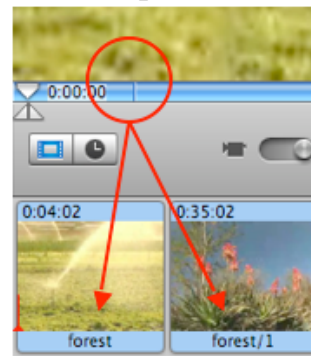
- 2 Drag the left triangle to where the first frame you want to delete. (Start)

Drag the right triangle to the last frame you want to delete. (Stop)

- 3 The yellow bar indicates the highlighted section.



- ✓ Select **Cut** from the **Edit Menu** (or hit the *Delete* key) to trim this selection. This will delete all selected frames from a clip
Note: If the selection is in the middle of a clip, it will separate the clip into two clips



- ✓ Select **Crop** from the **Edit Menu** to crop to this selection. This will delete all unselected frames from a clip.
